Enjoy great views of the valley and ocean as you hike the Wildlife Corridor through our Puente Hills. This is an advancement opportunity for all Scouting levels.

Troop 546 will take your Unit's photo, then transport your group from the parking lot to the trailhead. The trail will be marked with red flags. Leaders will be given a map.

Skyline Hike commemorative patches will be available for purchase at \$5.00 each.

There is no cost for the hike but a donation of \$2.00 per person to offset operating expenses would be appreciated.

DIRECTIONS TO THE SKYLINE HIKE:

Check-In Point

Rio Hondo Community College is located at 3600 S. Workman Mill Road, Whittier 90601. Parking Lot 2A.

From San Gabriel Valley

Take the 605 Freeway South, exit at Peck Road and turn left.

From Orange County

Take the 5 Freeway North, to the 605 North, exit at Rose Hills Road and turn right onto Rose Hills Road. Turn left on Workman Mill Road and proceed ½ mile—the college is on the right.

SKYLINE HIKE MILEAGE, TIMES, & PICK-UP POINTS:

- 2 Miles** The 2 mile hikers should be picked up at the corner of Skyline Drive and Turnbull Canyon Road. (Thomas Guide 677G4). 2 Mile hikers should check-in by 10:00 AM.
- 5 Miles** The 5 mile hikers should be picked up at the corner of Colima Road and Camino Del Sur. (Thomas Guide 678A6). 5 Mile hikers should check-in by 9:00 AM.
- 6 Miles** The 6 mile hikers should be picked up at the corner of Hacienda Blvd. and Buddhist Temple. (Thomas Guide 678C7). 6 Mile hikers should check-in by 8:00 AM.
- 11 Miles** The 11 mile hikers should be picked up at the corner of North Harbor Blvd. and Fullerton Road. - just south of East Pathfinder Road (Thomas Guide 708J1). 11 Mile hikers should check-in by 7:00 AM.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION (PLEASE READ):

- 1. Each group is responsible for picking-up their own hikers at the end of their hike.**
- 2. At the 11 Mile Hike pick-up point; Fullerton Road intersects North Harbor at 2 points (horseshoe)! The 11 mile hike completion point is at the corner of N. Harbor Blvd and the northern Fullerton Road intersection (just south of East Pathfinder Road and the Pathfinder Community Regional Park)**

For your safety, please do not hike back to the starting point if the flag markers have been pulled up. The Skyline Trail is a public trail open to all. Boy Scouts of America provides insurance for their members, however all other hikers assume their own risk and responsibility. Units are responsible for securing a Tour Permit and Permission Slips for all participants.
