Between Rosecrans Ave. and Imperial Hwy., atop a small hill on the west side of Euclid St. *"Look for the Balloons"*

91 Fwy - Exit Euclid St., drive north to address.

Approx. drive time from Freeway: 10 minutes.

57 Fwy - Exit Imperial Hwy, travel west.

Turn left (south) on Euclid St., drive to address.

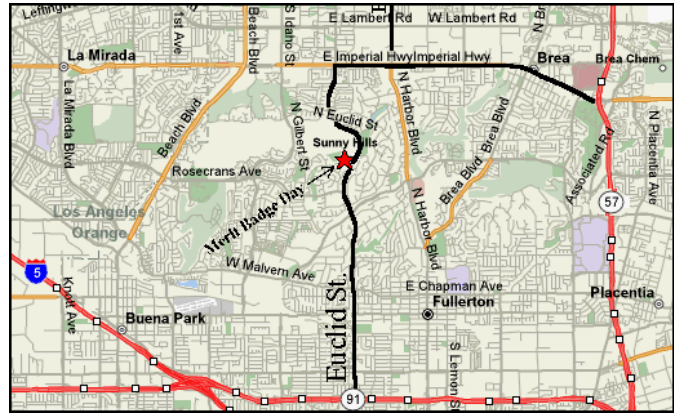
Approx. drive time from Freeway: 10 minutes.

Your Preparation & Prerequisites

Art - read the book, do requirements 1, 2 & 4.

***Citizenship in the Nation** - read the book, do requirements 2, 3, 6, & 8 and bring proof (parental proof OK.).

***Citizenship in the World** - read the book, do requirements 3, 4, & 7 and bring proof. Be prepared to discuss all requirements in class.

Collections - read the book, do requirements 1, 2 & 5b. Requirements 2 & 5b should be explained in your essay for Requirement 1.

Bring your collection, if possible. If not, bring proof of your collection.

***Communications** - read the book, do requirements 3, 4, 5, 7 & 8 and bring proof. Scoutmaster's approval is OK for #5.

Computers - read the book, do requirements 6, 7 & 10 and bring proof.

Dog Care - read the book, do requirements 3, 4 & 8.

***Emergency Preparedness** - read the book, do requirements 1, 2, 6c, 7, 8 & 9 and bring proof.

Energy - read the book, do requirements 1a, 4, 5, 6 & 8.

Fingerprinting - read the book, be prepared to discuss requirements and to take fingerprints in class.

***First Aid** - read the book, do requirement 2d (new 2008 requirement) and bring proof. Be prepared to demonstrate First Aid procedures.

This class will require both sessions on Merit Badge Day. See the note below or our website (www.troop86vipers.com) for full details.

Genealogy - read the book, do requirements 2, 3, 4b, 5 and bring information for requirements 6 & 7.

Golf - read the book, do requirements 8 and bring proof (scorecards).

Indian Lore - read the book, do requirements 1, 2a, 2d, 3c & 4i and bring proof.

Medicine - read the book, do requirements 7a & 10.

Music - read the book, do requirements 2, 3 & 4 and bring the paperwork for requirements 2 & 4. Bring your instrument (a piano will be on location). Counsellor approved music for requirement 1 is "Amazing Grace." Please obtain the music and be prepared to perform.

Skating - read the book and bring your Skates, Helmet, Knee & Elbow pads. **You must bring your safety equipment.** If you do not bring your **Skates, Helmet, Knee & Elbow pads**, you will not complete this merit badge.

Weather - read the book, do requirements 8 & 9 and bring diagram for requirements 3 & 6.

"Bring Proof" = pictures, original documents, printouts, actual items, a letter signed by a Scoutmaster, etc.

*** = Required for Eagle**

Special Instructions

All requirement numbers are from the official Boy Scout Requirements, 2008 edition. Scouts are to have completely read and studied all of the information in the **most current** merit badge books (many of the books have a new 2008 edition, please check and make sure your Scouts have the **most current** book) for the badges they desire to earn, prior to arriving for class. They should come to class fully prepared to discuss, report, demonstrate and be tested on **all** requirements for the merit badges they desire to earn. Scouts must bring their merit badge books, a pencil and paper, and a filled out "Blue Card" for each merit badge, **signed by his Scoutmaster**. Specific requirements that must be completed prior to class are listed above.

Each Scout **must bring appropriate proof of completion for all requirements listed above**, when stated. If a Scout cannot bring items to class because of size or logistics, the Scout must have a letter from his Scoutmaster as proof, and/or pictures of completions, written work, and drawings signed by the Scoutmaster.

Counselors will not pass Scouts whose work does not meet BSA standards. Scouts receiving partial blue cards are encouraged to continue working with their counselor to complete their requirement(s).

LUNCH: Lunch may be paid for at the time of registration. If you wish to pre-pay and reserve a lunch for your son, please include \$3 along with the \$17 cost of registration, for a total payment of \$20. Otherwise, snacks and drinks will also be available for purchase.

FIRST AID MERIT BADGE CLASS: The Orange County Council Advancement Committee requires the First Aid Merit Badge Class to extend over both sessions, in order for all the requirements to be fully completed. Therefore, if you wish to enroll in the First Aid class, please note that it will be the only class you can take on Merit Badge Day. Be sure to fill in alternate choices #3 & #4 in case the First Aid Class is full.
