

# 2010 Orange Frontier District Camporee Webelosree

## Scout Golden Spoon Competition



### *Invasion of the Tummy Snackers*

1. Each troop is allowed ONE Golden Spoon Patrol for the competition.
2. Entry cost is \$10 per Patrol by March Roundtable, 3/11/2010. **\$20 per Patrol by April Roundtable 4/8/2010. \$25 from 4/9/2010 – 4/16/2010 (last day to register).**
3. There is no minimum or maximum limit to the number of scouts per patrol participation.
4. Each patrol will be assigned a minimum 10' x 10' perimeter within the Golden Spoon area.
5. Each patrol must provide all cooking equipment, table, food, and supplies.
6. NO ADULTS are allowed inside the Golden Spoon cooking area once competition has begun.
7. Judges will be present for the duration of the contest.
8. Each patrol must prepare their entire meal within the designated Golden Spoon cooking area
9. The Golden Spoon competition begins at 3:00 pm Saturday. Units can bring their equipment and supplies starting 2:30 pm. Setup starts @ 3:00 pm - entire cooking equipment, stoves, and work area must be completed by 4:00 pm.
10. All meals must be ready for judging by 5:30 pm and no later than 6:00 pm.
11. Each patrol will be cooking enough for their patrol PLUS one meal for judging and judging consumption.
12. Each patrol must provide a full menu to include an appetizer, salad, entrée, side dish and dessert.
13. The following will be provided: : butter, oil, olive oil, spices (salt, pepper, garlic, various herbs and seasonings – look at your parents spice rack, the common table at the competition will look like that).
14. Judging of the patrol will be by **total points (P) earned divided by total cost of meal and decorations (C) divided by number of scouts participating (S).**
  - Final Score: = P / (C/S)
15. All patrols must submit receipts for all materials purchased for the competition prior to beginning food preparations. **No exceptions.** If you make thematic decorations or costumes, keep any receipts and they will be part of your total expense. If you own, say a Spacesuit, you will not need a receipt. Otherwise, document all Golden Spoon expenditures.
